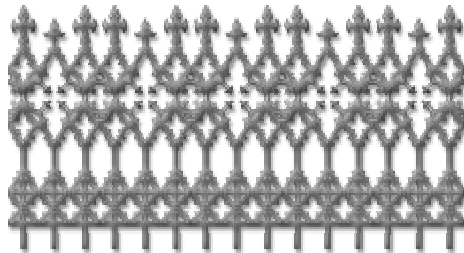
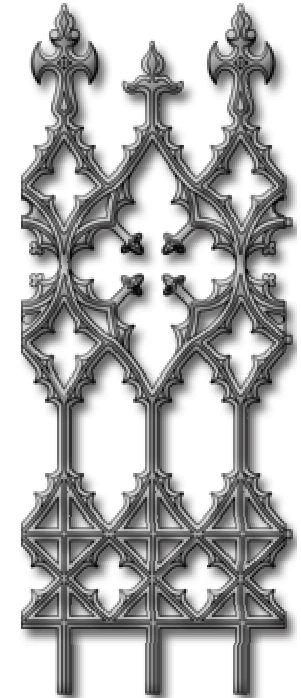
Grace Fence

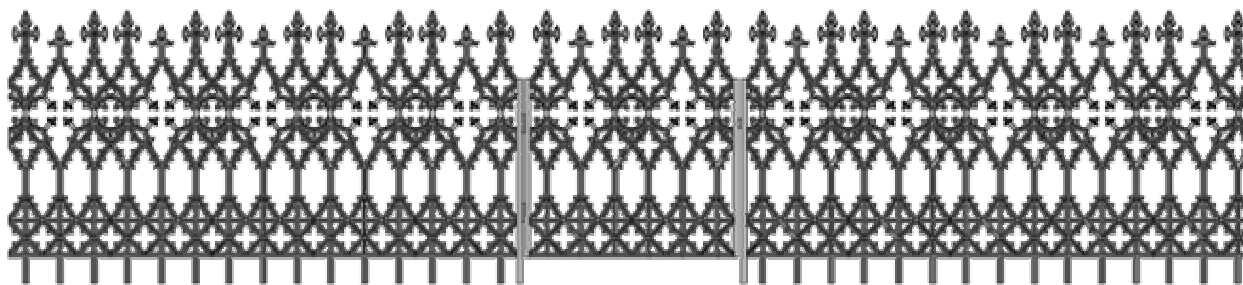
